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HLTCPR201A Course = Perform CPR

The purpose of the course in Apply CPR is to provide participants with the skills and knowledge to administer Expired Air Resuscitation and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation following a life-threatening incident.

Duration:

The course in Apply CPR is generally conducted over a 3 hour period. However this may vary depending on group size, previous experience and workplace requirements.

Entry requirements:

Nil, however it is recommended that participants have literacy and numeracy competencies equivalent to National Reporting System (NRS) Level 2:

Class Size:

Normally a minimum of six (6) participants is required and a maximum of 12 participants is allowed.

\$70 a group rate applies to families or groups of 5 or more)

Assessment:

Assessment methods for perform CPR include skills acquisition during the workshop, via multi choice examination and by individual participation within the group.

Certificates:


